IMITATION BAITES



POP-UP SWEETCORN (quantity 10)

The original and best imitation corn that has taken the carp world by storm. Often copied but never bettered, our buoyant corn has captured thousands of big carp, including a former British record as well as specimen roach, tench and bream. Soft enough to use directly on the hook, but most effective when hair rigged, either popped up on its own, or combined with real corn to produce a critically balanced bait.

Available in yellow, orange, red, black, white and fluoro red, orange, pink and yellow.

Angling Times review: They really do work!

SINKING SWEETCORN (quantity 10)

Offering an alternative presentation to our pop-up sweetcorn, our sinking imitation corn has been developed to sink like a real grain of corn, mimicking a free offering. Ideal for pressured fish that may be wary of a popped up bait.

Resistant to the unwanted attention from nuisance species including crayfish, and tough enough to withstand casting, the angler is always guaranteed a hook bait.

We recommend hair rigging with a longish hair to give the most natural presentation.



MINI SWEETCORN (quantity 10)

Our mini corn can be used on its own or in conjunction with real corn, either hooked direct or mounted on a hair rig. Ideal for most species, particularly fish that may be wary of larger baits. For best results fish over a bed of particles, pellets etc.

CAMO CORN (quantity 3)



POP-UP MAIZE (quantity 5)

Buoyant imitation maize soft enough to use on the hook or hair rig. Can be used popped up on its own or in conjunction with real maize, to produce a critically balanced hook bait. Resists the attention of nuisance species including crayfish.

Individual grains may vary in buoyancy, but as a general guide: one grain will pop up a size 8 carp hook.

SINKING MAIZE (quantity 8)

Maize, our sinking imitation maize has been developed to sink like a real grain of maize, mimicking a free offering. Ideal for pressured fish that may be wary of a popped up bait.

Resistant to the unwanted attention from nuisance species including crayfish, and tough enough to withstand casting, the angler is always guaranteed a hook bait.

We recommend hair rigging with a longish hair to give the most natural presentation.



IMITATION FLAKE MAIZE (quantity 10)

A buoyant imitation flake of maize that is ideal for use with method mix groundbaits, or other feeds containing particles and flakes. Super soft, yet tough enough to stay on a hook or hair rig, even when distance casting. Ideal when fished as a slow sinking hook bait in conjunction with the bagging waggler method on the commercial pools, or for the big carp angler fishing over a bed of bait.

ARTIFICIAL HEMP (quantity 10)

A realistic looking buoyant imitation split grain of hemp, that can be used directly on a hook or hair rig. A soft white rubber kernal makes hooking easy and ensures that the hook stays firmly in place. Helps to counterbalance the weight of the hook.

Use a single grain on a size 18, or multiple grains on a larger hook or hair rig. As a guide: ten grains will counterbalance a size 10 specimen type hook.



POP-UP PELLETT (Seafood flavour)

Buoyant imitation Pellet soft enough to use on the hook or hair rig. Contains real fish oil and shellfish flavour. Resists the attention of nuisance species including crayfish. Best fished over a PVA bag of pellets. Available in 6mm (quantity 8), 10mm (quantity 5), and a mixed pack of 14mm and 18mm (quantity 2+2).

BLOODWORM / SHRIMP PELLETS (With Belachan)

Available in 5mm (quantity 14), 8mm (quantity 8)

Our imitation bloodworm/shrimp pellet contains real fish oil with belachan (fermented shrimp), and are soaked in a worm and shrimp flavour.

Super soft yet tough, they make an ideal hooker pellet when used with real shrimp or bloodworm pellets. No need for constant rebaiting, the angler is always guaranteed a hook bait.

Although buoyant, they can be counter-balanced with an appropriate sized hook to produce a slow sinking or critically balanced hook bait.



ARTIFICIAL BLOODWORM (Quantity 20) Includes two different sizes.

A soft buoyant imitation bloodworm that can be used directly on a hook or hair rig. Resists the attention of nuisance species whilst targeting specimen fish. Stays firmly on the hook, no need for constant rebaiting. Helps counter-balance the weight of the hook.

POP-UP PEANUT (quantity 5)

Buoyant imitation Peanut that can be used directly on a hook or hair rig. Best used in conjunction with real peanuts to produce a popped up or critically balanced bait.

Individual nuts may vary in buoyancy, but as a general guide: one Pop-up Peanut will pop up one or two real Peanuts of a similar size, approximately 20mm, with a size 6 hook.



POPUP TIGER NUT (quantity 5) Includes two different shapes of nut.

A buoyant imitation Tiger nut, soft enough to use on the hook or hair rig. They contain Tiger nut flavour and are resistant to the attentions of nuisance species including Crayfish. Can be used on a hair in combination with real nuts to produce a critically balanced bait, or fished popped up on their own.

IMITATION DOG BISCUIT (quantity 5) Includes two different sizes.

Buoyant imitation Dog biscuit, soft enough to use on the hook or hair rig. Our imitation Dog biscuits have been developed to overcome some of the problems associated with other similar products currently available. The inclusion of a counterweight into one side, ensures that the hook always remains on top, out of view of any wary fish. It also ensures that the imitation biscuit sits low in the water, just like a real biscuit that has become waterlogged.





IMITATION BREAD (quantity 4)

Our imitation bread is extremely buoyant and soft, yet is tough enough to stay firmly on a hook or hair rig during casting, and also resist the unwanted attention from nuisance species. Can be cut or torn into chunks to expose the fluffy, sponge like interior, that will readily absorb a liquid flavour.

IMITATION LUNCHEON MEAT (quantity 1 40mm x 28mm x 12mm thick)

Soft and buoyant our imitation luncheon meat is extremely tough, and will not fly off when cast. Use in conjunction with real meat to produce a popped up or critically balanced bait. Can be cut or torn into chunks to expose the sponge like interior, that will readily absorb a liquid flavour.



RUBBER GRUBS (quantity 20)

Rubber Grubs are a supersoft, buoyant imitation maggot that can be used to produce a critically balanced or popped-up bait. They are best used in conjunction with real maggots when a slow sinking or balanced hook bait is required, e.g. when fishing over bottom weed or when fish are taking on the drop. They are also useful where small fish are a nuisance constantly tearing real maggots off the hook. Alternatively they can be used to pop up a bait, when matched with an appropriate hook size.

Available in red, bronze or white, 20 per pack (15 large and 5 small). The two sizes allow for flexibility when balancing various makes of hook. Now also available in a harder version for use with the deadly mag-aligner rig, as devised by Rob Maylin. 20 large per pack.

RUBBER CASTER (quantity 20, assorted colours)

Rubber Casters are a buoyant imitation caster that are soft enough to use directly on a hook or hair rig. They can be used singularly, in combination with other baits, or in multiples on a hair rig. Their buoyancy helps to counterbalance the weight of the hook, and they are resistant to the attentions of small nuisance fish.



ETERNAL BOILIES THE EVERLASTING POPUPS

Quantity. Pellet x 7, 12mm x 8, 15mm x 5, 18mm x 4.

Our imitation Boilies include a hole in one side, enabling a weight to be added to create a critically balanced or sinking bait. Alternatively it can be filled with an absorbent substance, soaked in a concentrated flavour of the angler's choice.

Their buoyancy remains the same, even after prolonged use, and they are resistant to the attentions of nuisance species including Crayfish.

Available in a range of colours/sizes including pellet shape, and also ready flavoured with our own liquid flavour combinations, in a handy mini glug pot.

BAIT PRESENTATION

PASTEMATE

The Pastemate was designed to alleviate two common problems associated with paste fishing, i.e. missing bites due to the hook point being covered, and the paste coming off during casting. It is basically a rubber ball that has a stem attached to it, through which the hook is passed.

The paste is then moulded around the ball, stem and shank of the hook, leaving the point and part of the bend exposed. The stem can easily be shortened with scissors to suit bait size.

The Pastemate can be positioned at any point on the hook to suit the angler's requirements, e.g. with the hook point coming out of the side or top of the ball of paste. It can be easily removed from barbless or semi-barbless hooks, and reused, or left on a barbed hook at the end of a session that you intend to use again.

Available in two sizes: **small** - to suit hook sizes 12-18 (12 per pack); **standard** - to suit hook sizes 4-12 (10 per pack).

Angling Times review: Perfect pastemate!





PASTEMATE HAIR (quantity 10)

The Pastemate Hair Rig version is a quick and simple to use hair rig replacement that can easily be fitted and removed, should a change of bait be required. They are attached to the hook via a small length of silicone tube cut from the length provided. They are suitable for use with all types of paste, and the "hair" can be lengthened by stretching, to suit bait size.

BAIT ANCHORS (quantity 12 per pack)

The Bait Anchor is available in two different designs: a **standard version** - to fish a bait directly off the back of the hook (great for floaters); and a **hair rig version**. The hair version comes in two lengths to suit 14mm and 18mm boilies or pellets. Both have a 10mm long hair. Six of each per pack.



Both designs of Bait Anchors do away with the need for fiddly hair stops, and can be attached to the hook in seconds. Both versions are suitable for use with boilies, nuts, pellets, luncheon meat, chum mixers, etc. Both designs are available in a **starter pack** containing 12 of each, along with a 2.5mm diameter stainless steel bait drill. This is larger than a standard nut/boilie drill, and is for use specifically with the Bait Anchor, when any hard bait is required to be used. Softer baits, like luncheon meat can be used simply by pushing the Bait Anchor through the meat until the anchor arms spring out.



Angling Times review: Simple and effective hair rigs.

MEAT MATE (quantity 8)

The Meatmate is a specially designed hair stop for use with soft meats, such as luncheon meat/meatballs etc, that simply hooks into the hair loop. When used with the tubing provided, it greatly reduces the cheese wire cutting effect normally associated when hair rigging meat. It can also be used as an effective anchor point for hair rigged paste baits, and can be quickly removed should a change to meat boilies etc. be required.



WORM STOP (quantity 24)

The Worm Stop is a simple but effective soft rubber stop that prevents lively worms wriggling off a barbless or semi-barbless hook.

They come in a pack of 24, along with an applicator tool, which is used to put the Worm Stops onto the hook. They can be reused many times and are suitable for use with hook sizes 4-14. Great when used with lobworms on a size 6 or 8 barbless hook!

BOILIE SPIKE (quantity 14)

Suitable for use with all types of boilie, including popups, as well as tiger nuts, maize etc. It comes in two lengths, the longer version ideal for double baits and snowman rigs. The pack contains both sizes that can be cut to suit any size of bait. No fiddly hair stops, you can re-bait in seconds. Simply tie to hair and push into the bait.



HOOK SKINS (quantity 24)

Soft imitation pupa / larvae for use with hair rigged baits, in clear water conditions. Camouflages the hook and eliminates glint from the sun, which may spook wary fish. Two colour options 12 of each per pack, for use over silt or gravel. Buoyancy helps to counterbalance the weight of the hook.

We are the U.K's leading manufacturer of imitation baits and were the first company to produce the now famous "Popup sweetcorn". The following Q & A explains how Frank uses our products to maximum effect.

Frank can you give us an insight into how you get the best out of plastic hook baits.

It's quite a big subject really, and one that I've got the confidence to use in most situations. Basically, there are certain advantages you get with "decoy"baits- as I call them- when fishing over other baits. Take pellets as an example. If you're using trout pellets the main problem is your hook bait swelling up, and you're never sure if your bait is still on especially if you're doing a night. The decoy pellets are ideal in that situation. If the carp are feeding confidently, you want to use something that they are likely to suck up into their mouths and a fake pellet fits that description perfectly.

With plastic baits I've not done that well fishing them individually, I have always used them in the decoy situation. The carp actually think it's a piece of food and will take it in as one. By that time, if your rigs are doing their job, it's all over bar the screaming.

When I use fake corn I tend to use it with the method or with mixed pellets and lots of corn in a PVA bag. I've caught loads of carp in that scenario, but not a lot with just rubber corn and no free offerings, my preference is to have a little patch of food nearby.

A lot of anglers think plastic baits are working well because they don't have any smell. The fake boilies appear to be completely washed out, which could be a reason for their success. I'm not sure I agree with that myself, because although I have caught on the unflavoured ones, the flavoured ones seem to have been slightly better for me. You can get the unflavoured ones and put them in your own choice of attractors, whatever is in the make-up of the rubber certainly seems to draw liquids in.

I can't talk about artificial baits without mentioning the maggots. I've used the plastic maggots alongside real maggots, and because of their buoyancy, they are perfect to negate the weight of the hook. For every five maggots, put a plastic one on there, it's much better than using straight maggots as it sits the hook in a prone position on its point. This particular arrangement is far more likely to catch in a carp's mouth.



Frank Most of the plastic baits are buoyant, which may be another reason why anglers shy from them. What is your preference when using these baits? Do you pop them up?

A lot of the baits are buoyant and the boilies, maize and corn, as well as the others, will all lift your hook slightly. I like to counterbalance them with the smallest shot I can get away with. With the boilies there is a little recess in the side where you can insert a weight, I like to slide a shot into this.

I've heard of people using plastic on Zig Rigs, which is quite interesting. I know that the big common, Benson, was caught in winter on a white plastic boilie. It is certainly an effective strategy.

A real bait used alongside a fake one in a snowman arrangement has caught Frank lots of carp.

Frank In what situations would you keep the buoyancy in the baits, and by the same token, when would you balance them out?

When I used to use maize a lot, I was using real maize with a sliver of foam in-between. Overnight, the buoyancy of the bait would change. If I didn't get a take in the night I would reel in the hook bait and find the foam had taken on water and upset the balance of the rig. The plastic hook baits give you a constant buoyancy, what you get when you test the rig in the margins is what you will get three weeks later if necessary. The exact buoyancy is there, finely-tuned without ever altering.

I used the corn on Horseshoe, for example, in one of the fish with the stars events. I was using it with a bag of dried off corn and pellets and a few chops, and that was working brilliantly as I was fishing over light weed and the buoyancy remained constant.

Frank In what situations would you keep the buoyancy in the baits, and by the same token, when would you balance them out?

The best bit of advice I could give is that if you are using plastic baits, think about the way you apply them. Something I like to do is take a small film canister, fill it with sweetcorn juice, and leave the fake corn soaking in that. You end up with a natural-smelling and natural-looking bait with whatever type of corn you use, flavoured or unflavoured. It's good to impart that real smell with all of the artificial baits.

They're worth having in your box because you don't have to use them all the time. The only one I find myself constantly using is the fake corn, as I like to use sweetcorn a fair bit. I've caught dozens and dozens on it and recommend its use on any water, both home and abroad.

Frank You mentioned earlier about flavouring the baits. When would you use an added flavour and when would you prefer not to?

In the winter I would definitely use a flavour. If you're using single hook baits and you hear a carp crash, I think in that situation you want something they can easily find, in both daylight and darkness. You have 14 hours of darkness for most of the time in the winter, so you need a bit of smell there to help the carp home in on your hook bait, every edge helps.

Single hook baits have never been traditionally been good in the dark, but the plastic baits really seem to retain their flavour. If you reel in a plastic bait that's been out for hours the smell is still really potent. The rubber isn't porous but the flavour seems to get trapped in the molecules of the rubber compound used to make the baits. When opportunist fishing in the dark, you want something like that. In that situation I have found those baits to be extremely good.

TERMINAL TACKLE



ADJUSTER-LINK (quantity 4)

The Adjuster-Link is used for fixed paternoster legering with either a bomb or swimfeeder. It essentially replaces a three or four turn water knot. Its main advantage is that it can be repositioned to adjust the hook length without tying or re-tying any knots. Another advantage is that it does not weaken the line, something that a knot invariably does. There are two sizes available: **small** (14mm long), and **standard** (20mm long). The small version is ideal for close to medium range work with small to medium size bombs/feeders, and also where a delicate presentation is required.

The standard version is better suited for medium to long range fishing with heavier bombs/feeder. Both sizes are ideal for use where powerful fish are expected, and the advantage of being able to fish straight through to the hook becomes very apparent.

Angling Times review: Sound Idea!

ADJUSTER-STOP (quantity 4)

A unique design leger stop with built-in shock bead that can be fitted quickly and simply.

The line enters and leaves the Adjuster-Stop centrally, streamlining the rig, and it does not damage or weaken the line. When assembled it measures approximately 18mm long, and produces a stand off anti tangle effect when in use. Like the Adjuster-Link, it enables the angler to fish straight through when targeting powerful fish, and basically replaces the usual swivel and rubber bead set-up. It can be easily repositioned on the main line by removing and refitting the two rubbers, should the angler wish to alter the hook length. Can also be used as a controller float stop when floater fishing.

Angling Times review: Ingenious kit for the leger angler!



PROTECT-A-BEAD (quantity 10)

The Protect-A-Bead is a special bead that has a sleeve attached to it that slides down over the hook length swivel. This protects the knot and swivel from damage due to gravel abrasion and buffeting by the lead.

Available in two sizes: **small**-to suit swivel sizes 10-14; and **standard**-to suit swivel sizes 5-10.

7mm BEAD (quantity 10)

A slightly oval 7mm diameter shock absorbing bead with a tapered hole in one side that can be pushed onto the eye of a hook length swivel if desired.

Both 7mm and Protect-A-Bead are available in black or a mixed pack of Green and Brown.

7mm LUMINOUS BEAD (quantity 10)

A glow-in-the-dark version of our standard 7mm bead. Particularly useful for the small river angler, or any close range work where an underarm cast is used. They enable the angler to keep track of the leads position during the pendulum swing, ensuring greater timing and accuracy of the cast.



SNAG SAFE LINK CLIP (quantity 5)

Designed for use with a running link leger, or fixed paternoster set-up. Should the link become snagged, the clip will open under pressure to release the lead/feeder, freeing the rig. A length of silicone tube keeps the lead in place and helps to minimise tangles. Available in two sizes: **Small** - ideal for Chub/Barbel. Requires a straight pull of approximately 4lbs pressure to release, so we advise a minimum of 6lb line when using this product; **large** - suitable for Pike/Carp anglers using heavier leads. Requires a straight pull of 8-9lbs pressure to release, so we advise a minimum of 12lb line.

SNAG SAFE LEAD CLIP

New and improved making it the most versatile safety running leger system available to the specialist angler. The weight is attached to the large bore run ring via a plastic split ring, which will open under pressure to release the lead/feeder should it become snagged. The pack contains 3 run rings, 3 of our protect-a-beads in matching olive green, 3 high strength swivels and 20 split rings varying in release pressure from approx 2lb to 12lb, to suit a multitude of angling situations and line breaking strains. The length of silicone tube used to hold the lead/feeder in place, becomes virtually invisible under water adding to the camouflage effect. **Snag Safe Lead Clip** is used by some of the country's top angler's.





SWIMFEEDER LINE CLIP (quantity 3)

Suitable for side weighted maggot, open end and wire mesh feeders. Enables hook length to be fished close to the feeder, creating a bolt-rig effect, but allows it to pull free, leaving the angler in direct contact with the fish. Tension control nut allows for fine adjustments to suit line diameter. Reduces tangles when casting.

ACCESSORIES



ADJUSTER STRAP (quantity 1)

Adjustable strap to help locate items of tackle at night. Suitable for use on rod rests, bank sticks, landing nets, pod legs etc. Complete with rechargeable luminous glow stick that glows for up to 8 hours. Can be replaced with an isotope if required. Fits diameters from 8mm to 20mm. We recommend that you use our U.V. Torch for quick and easy charging.

NIGHTLITE ADAPTORS

Suitable for use with Isotopes and other chemical nightlites, diameter 3-4.5mm. They incorporate a soft rubber core that ensures a secure grip on a wide range of tip diameters. Simply fold around the tip and secure in place with the silicone tube provided. Can be fitted and removed in seconds.



Quivertip Nightlite Adaptors:

Contains one small adaptor for fine/medium tips, and one adaptor for thicker tips and rod tips up to 2mm diameter.

Avon/Barbel Rodtip Nightlite Adaptors:

Contains two adaptors for use with rod tips 2-2.6mm in diameter. This includes Avon style rods and Barbel rods of up to 13-4lb test curve.

Carp Rodtip Nightlite Adaptors:

Contains two adaptors for use with rod tips up to 3.2mm in diameter.



SEA ROD ADAPTOR

Specially designed for beachcasters our adaptors are suitable for use with Isotopes and other chemical nightlites, diameter 3 - 6mm. They incorporate a soft rubber core that ensures a secure grip on tip diameters up to 5.5mm. Simply fold around the tip and secure in place with the tube provided. Can be easily fitted and removed as required.

Comes complete with a pack of two starlites.

STARLITE SL 1+2: * Contains two single use starlites, for use with our sea rod adaptor.

STARLITE SL 5: * Contains two single use starlites, for use with our coarse adaptors.

SIGHT TIPS 22mm x 3mm (quantity 6)

Ideal for use with our night lite adaptors or most insert waggler type floats. Our sight tips come in three colours, fluoro yellow and orange for daytime and luminous neon green for night time use. We recommend our U.V torch for quick and easy charging.

Pack contains 2 x fluoro yellow, 2 x fluoro orange and 2 x neon green.

NIGHTMATE*

Featuring a multi angle swivel head and belt clip, with a magnetic insert for attaching to any square steel frame chair/bedchairs etc. The light operates by micro switch when the head is lifted.

PIC STICK

Quick and simple to use aid for self portrait photography. Ensures that you and the fish are in every photo. The camera is set on a tripod or adjustable bank stick at a suitable distance from the pic stick. Now looking through the view finder, the auto focus mark is set on the white sight board. With the fish, position yourself behind the pic stick holding the fish central to the sight board. The pic stick is hinged so that it falls out of shot when knocked. The white sight board makes night shots simple.

SPECIALIST BOBBIN

Our specially designed bobbin offers an alternative to the carp style dangles, commonly used today. Offering minimal resistance to a taking fish, it comes with three sizes of interchangeable stainless steel weights, and two "hangers", white for daytime and luminous green for night use. (We recommend our U.V torch for quick and easy charging). Isotopes or chemical lights can be easily fitted as well if preferred. Supplied with a special clip that holds the bobbin when casting, playing fish, or simply when roving from swim to swim. The clip can be either whipped permanently to the rod or fixed with insulating tape.



SPECIALIST BUTT GRIPPER

Our Butt Gripper rear rest has been designed to assist rod placement and location at night, and give a secure grip on either duplon, cork or rod blanks. The fit can be initially adjusted to suit different diameters by either pushing in or pulling apart the side arms. Comes complete with a rubber ring for ease of alignment on a buzzer bar setup.

The Butt Gripper is available in 3 versions:-

Clear with twin high power isotopes and 4 luminous inserts, for continuous all night illumination.

Clear with 8 luminous inserts, that glows for 3 to 4 hours before recharging.

Black with 4 luminous inserts, and 4 dayglow yellow inserts for added day time visibility.

We recommend that you use our U.V. Torch for charging the luminous inserts.

SPECIALIST ROD REST

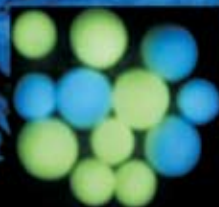
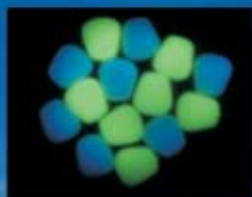
